

# 2024 Contributions & Charges

### **Dear Families**

This document outlines the voluntary contributions and possible maximum charges for 2024 which have been endorsed by the School Board. The schedule will allow you to calculate the maximum cost that may be incurred for school activities. It is a requirement of the Education Act 1999 that these be declared and published.

## Voluntary Contribution – Kindergarten to Year 6 \$60.00

This is a once off payment assisting us to provide appropriate resources and high quality teaching and learning programs. Everything from art and craft materials to sports equipment and core curriculum essentials. This amount complements other funding sources, including from State and Federal Governments. This \$60 goes a very long way and equates to just **\$1.50 per week**. This is the amount we ask **every** family to pay for **each** child attending school and may be made using the following options:

- Tick the box when placing your child's Personal Items Order (Booklist);
- EFTPOS in the office, or over the phone;
- Through Compass Billing (from Term 2);

# All contributions are used for the direct benefit of all children. Our aim is to raise our community's contribution rate to 90%. In 2023, 89% was received.

#### Charges – Kindergarten to Year 6

These amounts vary from year to year. Students will only incur costs when they are actually involved in a particular activity. The values indicated on the table at the end of this document are an estimate of the maximum cost that could be charged across the year. These are for optional components of the education programs for which there is a cost. Participation in these activities are dependent on parents paying the costs at the time they occur.

#### P&C Approved Request

The Karrinyup Primary School P&C Association voluntary approved request is \$70.00 per child or \$140.00 for two or more children. In recent years, the P&C have raised money for school resources such as online resources, STEM resources, playground equipment, sporting equipment, buses for whole school special events, as well as building improvements around the school. This contribution can be paid with the Personal Items Order or directly into the P&C account. Please note – the school **does not** collect the P&C contribution – they should be paid seperately.

#### Personal Items Lists

All Personal Items Lists are on our website. Orders may be placed through West School Supplies as instructed on the sheet, or through your preferred supplier. Both the Voluntary Contribution and P&C contribution are listed for payment on the order form for your convenience. Every effort has been made to keep these lists to a minimum. It may be necessary to 'top up' some supplies throughout the year as needed.

#### Charges

Students incur a cost when they are involved in a particular activity only. The **estimated** values indicated for each year level (K-6) represent the **maximum** cost a parent should anticipate being charged for activities if the student were to participate in all activities likely to be planned.
