

KARRINYUP PRIMARY SCHOOL DRESS CODE

The Karrinyup Primary School Board has endorsed the reinforcement of all students adhering to the KPS Uniform Dress Code every day. Please note: Black pants / shorts / tights are **not** acceptable. Parents will be contacted if students are not meeting the standards expected and outlined below.

The School Board believes a school dress code:

- Assists in building school and team spirit
- Ensures students are safely dressed for specific school activities
- Encourages equity among students
- · Easily identifies Karrinyup PS students on and off the school site

Hats	School logo Broad brimmed hat
Polo shirt	Royal blue, short sleeved with collar and school logo
Faction t-shirts	Faction t-shirts with the school logo can be worn on Fridays only
Jackets	Royal blue zip-up jackets
Jumper	Royal blue poly cotton fleece
Shorts	Royal blue, micro fibre or rugby knit
Skorts	Royal blue yoked skirt. Bike pant attached inside.
Skirts	Royal blue pleated netball skirt
Track pants	Royal blue fleece track pants
Dress	Light weight checked dress with school logo
Jazz Pant	Royal blue straight leg
KPS Leavers polo & jackets	Year 6 students only
Tights / leggings	Royal blue or navy

All clothing items must be Karrinyup Primary School uniform items.

Other considerations:

Jewellery	1 x pair studs or 1 x pair sleepers or medic alert bracelets are the only types of jewellery to be worn. Watches may be worn.
Makeup	No makeup is to be worn. Clear nail polish is acceptable.
Long-sleeved shirts	Long-sleeved shirts of a closely matched pale blue colour can be worn under the school polo shirt.
Hair	Hair shoulder length or longer needs to be tied up with simple hair tie, elastic or ribbon.
Sports briefs	Recommended for girls to wear under dresses and pleated netball skirts
